History AutoCAD was originally released in December 1982. The company had previously sold their engineering software, Digital Project, to Hewlett Packard in 1980. The developers of AutoCAD used the Digital Project code and sold their services as a combination product. In 1989, AutoCAD was released on the Amiga platform. The first versions were released as a 16-bit binary format, but AutoCAD became a 32-bit application, because the platform could not handle the previous format. The name of the application refers to AutoCAD's strong emphasis on standard features, standardization, and the autocad© marks, originally a symbol created by the late John Walker for the Swiss Army. AutoCAD was the only program ever to use the autocad© symbol and continued to use it on company documents even after John Walker passed away. By the early 1990s, work began to move AutoCAD from 16-bit to 32-bit. This move was intended to allow AutoCAD to take advantage of the more powerful graphic capabilities of the Amiga 4000 chipset. In November 1990, during the 32-bit era, it was first released for Windows 3.x. From 1992 to 1995, it was only available on the Amiga platform. The final version of AutoCAD for Amiga was version 7. In 1995, AutoCAD was introduced for the Macintosh. It was initially available only on the Macintosh Plus. It has been available on the original Macintosh as well as the G3, G4, and Power Mac models from Apple. AutoCAD was also released for the first time on MS-DOS and IBM PC compatible operating systems (OS), and Unix systems. Autodesk AutoCAD for OS/2, version 1.0, was released in March, 1995, and later versions of AutoCAD for OS/2 used the DOS version of AutoCAD. Some features, such as stereo rendering, are now supported only in the OS/2 version of AutoCAD. In 1998, an additional version of AutoCAD for Windows 95 and NT 4.0 was introduced. The software runs on personal computers running Windows 95 and later versions. Later in 1998, AutoCAD was ported to Microsoft Windows 98 and Windows 2000. The same year, AutoCAD for OS/2 was replaced with the Windows version. AutoCAD was first released for the Macintosh in 1995.

These include: 1990 – The first patent for use of AutoCAD in architectural design by John Evans. Evans worked for Evans & Karr in Belleville, Illinois, and was developing a product to replace pencil and paper drafting with 3D CAD. Evans presented the first AutoCAD drawing to the NACIS convention in 1990. 1996 – A patent for increasing the efficiency of using a CAD system by means of navigation. 1999 – A patent for optimizing the use of a software CAD system by means of changing the interface to a paper CAD drawing. 2003 – A patent for improving the efficiency of using a CAD system by means of image-based metadata. 2004 – A patent for enabling a user to manage the creation and the exchange of CAD drawings in the workplace. 2007 – A patent for enabling a user to share a CAD drawing, or to edit a shared drawing, by means of allowing them to access the same drawing on

another computer, or on another network, without exposing their account data to another user. AutoCAD also has numerous other patents in various other fields.
